

## **Course Name: Hazard Recognition**

**Course Description:** The objectives of this course are to:

- Raise awareness of hazards in the workplace;
- Develop skills to recognise these hazards; and
- Develop the reporting skills needed to initiate corrective actions.

**Target Audience:** This course is intended for safety leaders, members of safety committees or other frontline workers who need to hone their hazard recognition skills.

**Course Outline:** The course will start with a tour of the workplace in which a video record of identified hazards will be completed. (The video will be left with the client at the end of the course.)

- The theoretical aspects of the course will be in a classroom setting and will cover all aspects of workplace safety.
- The students will then be shown the video and asked to identify the issues from their own workplace.
- The course will conclude with methods to initiate the reporting of the identified hazards using the clients own procedures, if they are available.

**Length of the Course:** 1 day.

**Course Location:** At the locations where the participants actually conduct their daily activities.

**Course Evaluation and Certification:** All participants will receive a JWTI Certificate of completion.

**Course Pre-requisites:** None.

**Materials:** Will be provided.

**Supplementary Reading(s):** Health and safety regulations in the jurisdiction appropriate to the participants.
